ASSEMBLY AND FITTING INSTRUCTIONS

INSTALLING THE SUSPENSION.

- 1. Set hard hat shell upside down on its crown. (Fig.1)
- 2. Line up suspension so that sweatband is at front next to brim. (Fig.2)
- 3. Push each clip into its slot and press firmly with the thumbs placed at the top of the clip until the tab it's snapped into place. (Fig.3)

ADJUSTING THE RATCHET SUSPENSION

4. Turn the knob counter-clockwise to open the headband to its maximum size. Place the hard hat on your head and push down on its top until the headband and shell are at a

comfortable height. (Fig.4)

5. Tighten the headband by turning the knob clockwise. DO NOT OVER-TIGHTEN. (Fig.5)

ADJUSTING THE PIN-LOCK SUSPENSION

- **6.** Insert nape strap through plastic buckles. (Fig. 6)
- 7. Press the pins into holes according your head size and wear the hard hat to test the sizing. (Fig. 7)
- 8. If too tight to be comfortable, remove hard hat and change nape strap pins for a larger size. If the headband is too loose to maintain the hard hat stable on head, remove it and adjust for smaller size. (Fig. 8)


